

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 AND SECTION 14 (I)(b) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2018-534, AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-670, THEREBY INCLUDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES NC II IN THE PROGRAMS QUALIFICATION OFFERED AT SIBUGAY PROVINCIAL TRAINING CENTER (SPTC) AND PROVIDING RULES AND FEES FOR INDIVIDUAL PAYING STUDENTS/TRAINEES CONSISTENT WITH THE CORRESPON-DING PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS PROVIDED INCLUDING THOSE NEWLY INTRODUCED BY WAY OF AMENDMENTS MADE THEREOF.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, 6th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of this province enacted on September 4, 2018 Ordinance No. 2018-534, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SIBUGAY PROVINCIAL TRAINING CENTER (SPTC), CONSTITUTING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE THEREOF, PROVIDING ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES OF THE INSTITUTION, PRESCRIBING FEES AND PAYMENTS, AND APPROPRIATING INITIAL FUNDS THEREFOR":

WHEREAS, Section 468(a) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, partly provides that: "The Sangguniang Panlalawigan, as the legislative body of the province, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the province and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the province as provided for under Section 22 of this Code;

WHEREAS, there is a need to upgrade the priority TESDA program qualifications to be offered at Sibugay Provincial Training Center, to include Emergency Medical Services NC II;

BE ENACTED, by the 8TH SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN of the **PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY**,

in session duly assembled, and

ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known and thereafter referred to as "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 AND SECTION 14 (I)(b) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2018-534, AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-670, THEREBY INCLUDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES NO II IN THE PROGRAMS QUALIFICATION OFFERED AT SIBUGAY PROVINCIAL TRAINING CENTER (SPTC) AND PROVIDING RULES AND FEES FOR INDIVIDUAL PAYING STUDENTS/TRAINEES CONSISTENT WITH THE CORRESPON-DING PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS PROVIDED INCLUDING THOSE NEWLY INTRODUCED BY WAY OF AMENDMENTS MADE THEREOF".

Section 2. <u>Amendments</u>. - (a) Section 13 of Provincial Ordinance No. 2018-534, as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 2024-670, is hereby amended further to read as follows:

- x. Barangay Health Services NC II;
- xi. Dressmaking NC II;
- xii. Health Care Services NC I;
- xiii. SMAW NC I;

The Provincial Governor shall be authorized to apply for other program qualifications with TESDA, as it may deemed necessary.

Section 3. Repealing Clause – All provisions or parts of Ordinance No. 2018-534, as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 2024-670 which are inconsistent to this Ordinance are hereby amended or modified accordingly.

Section 4. Separability Clause – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision hereof shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. *Effectivity.* – Pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Section 59 of Republic Act 7160 this ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days from the date a copy thereof is posted in a bulletin board at the entrance of the provincial hall, and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in this local government unit, and in the entrance of the municipal halls within the province of Zamboanga Sibugay.


